

TRIBULATION AND FALSE TRUTHS

What would it take to deceive you?

Matthew 24:21-24 - ²¹For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be.

²²And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened (This is a little flock, a remnant, and only the ones that obey God's commandments and have His spirit in them.).

²³Then if any man shall say unto you, Lo, here is Christ, or there; believe it not.

²⁴For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect. (They get their power from the Devil.)

Or have you been rooted in the truth of God? Isaiah 8:20 - ²⁰To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them. (If they speak not according to the Word of God it is because there is no light in them.)

Could the beast and false prophet be set up in the world to divert the truth of God? ¹³For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ (Not called to be leaders by God but self-appointed.).

¹⁴And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light (Not an angel of darkness and will deceive many for they make it appealing to the people; but they take the easy way and deceive many.).

¹⁵Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works (Satan's ministers). 2 Corinthians 11:13-15 (And when they stand before God He will say "I never knew you" for they got their religion from a different source than God; it was from Satan and he is a deceiver.)

This is a religion of deception and is Satanic worship because it is counterfeit. ²And the beast which I saw was like unto a leopard, and his feet were as the feet of a bear, and his mouth as the mouth of a lion: and the dragon (Satan) gave him his power, and his seat, and great authority.

³And I saw one of his heads as it were wounded to death; and his deadly wound was healed: and all the world wondered after the beast (except God's people).

⁴And they worshipped the dragon (Satan) which gave power unto the beast: and they worshipped the beast, saying, Who is like unto the beast? who is able to make war with him?

⁵And there was given unto him a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies; and power was given unto him to continue forty and two months (length of the tribulation).

⁶And he opened his mouth in blasphemy against God, to blaspheme his name, and his tabernacle, and them that dwell in heaven.

⁷And it was given unto him to make war with the saints, and to overcome them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations.

⁸And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

⁹If any man have an ear, let him hear (Don't fall for it.).

¹⁰He that leadeth into captivity shall go into captivity: he that killeth with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the patience and the faith of the saints (God is saying "vengeance is mine"; He will take care of the false church and its armies.).

¹¹And I beheld another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb (looks like a lamb but is counterfeit), and he spake as a dragon (Satan).

¹²And he exerciseth all the power of the first beast before him, and causeth the earth and them which dwell therein to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed.

¹³And he doeth great wonders, so that he maketh fire come down from heaven on the earth in the sight of men (Satanic counterfeit of Pentecost.),

¹⁴And deceiveth them that dwell on the earth (except God's people) by the means of those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; saying to them that dwell on the earth, that they should make an

image to the beast, which had the wound by a sword, and did live.
Revelation 13:2-14

Satan knows scripture; Christ did not fall for Satan's trap. ⁵Then the devil taketh him (Jesus) up into the holy city, and setteth him on a pinnacle of the temple,

⁶And saith unto him, If thou be the Son of God, cast thyself down: for it is written, He shall give his angels charge concerning thee: and in their hands they shall bear thee up, lest at any time thou dash thy foot against a stone.

Jesus Answered Satan and said ⁷Jesus said unto him, It is written again, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God.

⁸Again, the devil taketh him up into an exceeding high mountain, and sheweth him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them;

⁹And saith (Satan) unto him, All these things will I give thee, if thou wilt fall down and worship me.

¹⁰Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.
Matthew 4:5-10

Satan will try to deceive us all - ¹Behold, I will send my messenger, and he shall prepare the way before me: and the LORD, whom ye seek, shall suddenly come to his temple, even the messenger of the covenant, whom ye delight in: behold, he shall come, saith the LORD of hosts (Don't fall for the Satanic beast for he will sit in the Temple of God saying he is god, read below.). Malachi 3:1

³Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first (The beast, a particular person who will lead the falling away.), and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;

⁴Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God (pretends to be God), shewing himself that he is God. 2 Thessalonians 2:3-4

How deceptive will it be? ²⁷And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate (distribution of idols), even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.

(Satan will come as a peacemaker; but it will be the abomination of desolation spoken of in Matthew 24).

⁵But he (Jesus) was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed (Even though we rejected Him; the sickness that was in us He healed us and called us unto Him and we received His spirit after baptism.). Isaiah 53:5

¹⁵But God will redeem my soul from the power of the grave: for he shall receive me. Selah. Psalm 49:15

How evil will the false prophet and beast be; the beast will be in the temple of God

¹O clap your hands, all ye people; shout unto God with the voice of triumph.

²For the LORD most high is terrible; he is a great King over all the earth.

³He shall subdue the people under us, and the nations under our feet.

⁴He shall choose our inheritance for us, the excellency of Jacob whom he loved. Selah.

⁵God is gone up with a shout, the LORD with the sound of a trumpet.

⁶Sing praises to God, sing praises: sing praises unto our King, sing praises.

⁷For God is the King of all the earth: sing ye praises with understanding.

⁸God reigneth over the heathen: God sitteth upon the throne of his holiness.

⁹The princes of the people are gathered together, even the people of the God of Abraham: for the shields of the earth belong unto God: he is greatly exalted. Psalm 47:1-9

The beast will apply Godly titles to the Beast. ³⁶And the king shall do according to his will; and he shall exalt himself, and magnify himself above every god, and shall speak marvellous things against the God of gods, and shall prosper till the indignation be accomplished: for that that is determined shall be done. Daniel 11:36

The Beast is going to Jerusalem and will be the abomination of desolation in the Holy Place. ⁴⁵And he shall plant the tabernacles of his palace between the seas in the glorious holy mountain; yet he shall come to his end, and none shall help him.

The Beast will be in Jerusalem ²⁰And when ye shall see Jerusalem compassed with armies, then know that the desolation thereof is nigh.

²¹Then let them which are in Judaea flee to the mountains; and let them which are in the midst of it depart out; and let not them that are in the countries enter thereinto.

²²For these be the days of vengeance, that all things which are written may be fulfilled. (The great tribulation or time of Jacob's trouble.)

²³But woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck, in those days! for there shall be great distress in the land, and wrath upon this people.

²⁴And they shall fall by the edge of the sword, and shall be led away captive into all nations: and Jerusalem shall be trodden down of the Gentiles, until the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled. Luke 21:20-24

⁸In that day shall the LORD defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem; and he that is feeble among them at that day shall be as David; and the house of David shall be as God, as the angel of the LORD before them (God will be in their midst.).

⁹And it shall come to pass in that day, that I will seek to destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem.

¹⁰And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn (Their eyes will be open and true repentance will take place.). Zechariah 12:8-10

²And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the LORD of hosts, that I will cut off the names of the idols out of the land (The idols which took the place of God for it was idolatry.), and they shall no more be remembered: and also I will cause the prophets and the unclean spirit to pass out of the land (no more self-appointed leaders).

³And it shall come to pass, that when any shall yet prophesy, then his father and his mother that begat him shall say unto him, Thou shalt not

live; for thou speakest lies in the name of the LORD: and his father and his mother that begat him shall thrust him through when he prophesieth. Zechariah 13:2-3

Zechariah 14:1-4 – The Beast will say I am here to defend you but really to destroy them all. When we start doubting the truth of God and this opens the door for deception by Satan; we must hold true to the Words of God for He will take care of His people.

¹Behold, the day of the LORD cometh, and thy spoil shall be divided in the midst of thee.

²For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle; and the city shall be taken, and the houses rifled, and the women ravished; and half of the city shall go forth into captivity, and the residue of the people shall not be cut off from the city. (Battle of Armageddon)

³Then shall the LORD go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle (As God fought against the Egyptians at the Red Sea.).

⁴And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west (by an earthquake and will destroy the foe), and there shall be a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south. Zechariah 14:1-4

Why would I want to listen to Protestant ministers? They cannot receive God's spirit.

How do I know if he is Satan's ministers? Does the minister know the truth of God but are being used to teach deception.

What kind of state will we be in the tribulation? We must be led by the spirit of truth and slowly you will be deceived if we listen to false ministers. Believe what you know is the truth of God; don't be like the World-Wide Church of God which went back into false doctrine.

Matthew 24:23-24 - ²³Then if any man shall say unto you, Lo, here is Christ, or there; believe it not.

²⁴For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect. (No matter how hungry we are; remember what Christ has told us all in the above verses. Christ will come in the air and

the angels will be gathering God's people to meet Christ in the air and we will rise to meet Him in the air. The spirit of truth will lead us into all thuth. The false ministers do not have the spirit of truth for they do not know God. The spirit of truth will help us to recall all things and we may not have a Bible and that will make it easier to be deceived. We must read the truth of God and get it in our head for how much time do we have left?
